## Vision

The CCWA invests in Coaldale because we have deep roots here and want this vibrant community to grow. We value the health and well-being of individuals, families, and the community as a whole.

## Mission

The CCWA invests in the Coaldale community by sponsoring local events, providing scholarships to local high school students, and distributing grants for local projects, partnerships and programs throughout Coaldale and area.

## History

In the early 1920s, as Coaldale's population began to grow, the Mennonite settlers in the area recognized the need to establish accessibility to professional health care. They formed the Mennonite Health Society, which became the catalyst for raising money to build and furnish the first doctor's office and clinic in Coaldale. As Coaldale grew, the society constructed a total of four consecutively larger hospital buildings. In 1989, the present-day Coaldale Health Centre was built. In 2004, the operations of this hospital were transferred to the Chinook Health Region under the jurisdiction of Alberta Health Services.

Through an equity agreement, the Province of Alberta transferred \$2.2 million back to the Society stakeholders. From that, the Coaldale Community Wellness Association was formed to oversee and manage the funds.

## Grant Qualifications

Ensure that your organization and grant application meet the following CCWA grant funding guidelines:

- Your organization provides service programs in one or more of the following areas:
  - Health and wellness
  - Children, youth, seniors, families
  - Leadership and innovation
  - Promotes community involvement or participation, connection and/or collaboration
- Grants are provided for specific projects and are generally funded for one year only.
- Projects may benefit a group or the whole community.
- Grants should include details as to how the CCWA will be acknowledged in projects.
- Grant applications must contain indicators of success and outcome measures.
- All funding granted must be used to provide services in Coaldale and area, regardless of the location of your organization's administrative office.
- Organizations are encouraged to seek funding from alternate sources.
